WHAT IS **NATIONAL YOUNG STARS** *ALL ABOUT*?



The National Young Stars event is designed for 8-26 year olds (different age ranges apply for different competitions) who are passionate about the agricultural industry.

- The event promotes skills such as:
- Knowledge of the livestock industry
- Teamwork skills
- Communication skills
- **Creativity**
 - Time management
 - Showmanship
 - Public speaking

The event runs over two days and competitors are set a number of challenges including:

Stockjudging task - relevant to their team species.

- Promotional display where each team creates material to fit in a 3m shell scheme that showcases themselves, their sponsors, their animals and the theme of the event that year.
- Preparation two animals must be prepared in a specified time frame. Judges mark technique, handling of the animal and use of equipment.
- Ringcraft and interview two members of the team will parade the animals while one member of the team will take part in a public interview with our commentator.
- Skill-a-thon 25 multiple choice questions relating to their chosen livestock species.

We encourage everyone to visit the show by offering free entry. This allows people who would like to enter in the future an opportunity to learn.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

In order to enter the National Young Stars event the following is required:

Beef/dairy/sheep/pig competitions need to have three teammates.

The team must be entered by a sponsor or multiple sponsors (not just a breed society).

The entry fee is £150 for beef, dairy, dual purpose and sheep teams and £100 for pig teams. Payment must be sent along with the application.

Competitors must come together to coordinate elements such as their promotional display, selecting and arranging transportation of the team animals, the required TB testing of the animals and accommodation for the duration (camping is available on the showground).

The Beef/Dairy/Dual Purpose teams must be aged between 14 and 26 years of age. The Trimmed Sheep team must be aged between 11 and 26 and the Untrimmed Sheep and Pig teams must be aged between 8 and 26 years of age. All teams must have at least one member under the age of 18 at the time of the show.

PRIZES RANGE FROM

International exchange trips.

Products – such as clippers, show products, etc.

Vouchers – for companies such as Allflex, Showtime, etc.

Livestock equipment.

Educational visits – such as live to dead training.

Please remember once teams arrive on the showground no assistance can be given from outside help. Scrutineers will deduct points from those who have help during the show.

- > Judge six animals and give reasons on best four
- Team work judge as a team and nominate one individual to give reasons
- Tight time keeping and precise presentation

- > Demonstrate stock selection skills
- Confidence building
- Receive feedback from expert judges



PREPARATION AND PRESENTATION



- > Knowledge of effective clipping and presentation techniques
- > Teamwork making sure each member of the team takes on a task and is fully involved
- Confidence and ability to work with stock

INTERVIEW SKILLS:

- > Public speaking

- > Knowledge of industry when interacting with commentator



- > Health and safety when dealing with animals and electrical equipment
