I'm 14 years old and live on a dairy farm near Carmarthen. It was an honour to be asked to assist Malcolm Evans at this year's NSA show & sale. I really enjoyed the experience and learnt what a judge looks for.My interest in Torddu sheep began when I was 8 years old after starting to help Gareth Vince Jones with his flock of badgers. I bought my first 3 Torddu ewes from Dafydd Harries when I was 9 years old.

I took a yearling ram up to the Royal Welsh Show when I was 11 and was shocked to win 3rd prize. I have since shown both Torddus and Torwens at the Royal Welsh every year and successfully winning 2nd and 3rd prizes, but still waiting to win a 1st!! I also show at local shows.

Gareth has taught me what to look for in a Torddu – the markings, small ears etc, now to prepare a sheep for the show ring and how to hold a sheep once in the show ring. I still haven't trimmed yet – I'm still watching and learning. I enjoy showing and speaking to other society members and getting some tips from them.

I have decreased my number of sheep in order to continually improve my flock. I now have 3 rams and approx 40 ewes. I also have a flock of Torwens too. I look forward to keep showing my sheep and maybe one day I will get that red rosette at the Royal Welsh Show, and you never know, maybe one day I'll be a judge there.
