## RHEOLAU / RULES

The competitive rules shown below are applicable to and bind all exhibitors at this event.

1. The event venue is licensed by DEFRA and any regulations relating to animal movements and identification will apply to this event.
2. All exhibitors must be fully paid up members of the Badger Face Welsh Mountain Sheep Society in their own right, with the exception of entrants in the Young Handlers Section.
3. Exhibitors are restricted to six entries per section and no more than two entries per class. (except where stated in the schedule).
4. All sheep in the Open and Novice sections must be fully registered with the Badger Face Welsh Mountain Sheep Society.
5. Sheep entered into the Open Classes are not permitted to be entered into the novice class and vice versa.
6. Entry Fee - £10 per Exhibitor (excluding Young Handlers). Entries will be processed once entry fee is received.
7. Entries will open on 1<sup>st</sup> June and will close on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2026.
8. Entries can be made online or by post. It is the responsibility of the member to ensure that the entry form has arrived by post.
9. Exhibitors may indicate on the entry form whether or not the animal is for sale and this will appear in the catalogue.
10. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that animals entered are eligible and that the information given is accurate.
11. The use of any substance containing toxic chemicals, including sheep dips, to prepare sheep for showing, whilst on the showground, is prohibited.
12. All sheep must carry the appropriate UK tags and must be accompanied by a completed AML1 license. Exhibitors to complete 2 licenses for arrival at the show – 1 x on movement and 1 x off movement.
13. Exhibitors showing in the cross bred section, where tails have been docked, must comply with the 1982 Short Tail Docking of Sheep regulation, in that tails need to cover the anus in males and the vulva in females.
14. Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that all sheep entered are fit and healthy for the event. All exhibitors should be vigilant on loading.
15. Any animal(s) recovering/showing visible healing scabs from Orf around the mouth, Sheep Scab or any other potential contagious disease should not be brought on to the site.
16. No exhibitor may tamper with another exhibitor's animal. If an exhibitor is concerned over the welfare of another person's animal, please inform a Badger Face Welsh Mountain Sheep Society official.
17. The judges decision is final.
18. All persons are admitted to the showground at their own risk and vehicles and their accessories and contents are admitted to and left on the show-ground at the owner's risk.
19. Pens for exhibits will be allocated once entry numbers are known. However exhibitors are asked to specify on the entry form how many pens they would

- prefer. The Badger Face Welsh Mountain Sheep Society cannot guarantee that the requested number of pens will be available.
20. Classes will be as listed provided there are sufficient entries. The Badger Face Welsh Mountain Sheep Society reserves the right to combine or amalgamate classes if it so decides.
  21. Except where specified in the schedule, showing will take place in the designated ring(s). Exhibitors are expected to wear white coats.
  22. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be present in the judging ring at the commencement of judging, otherwise the exhibitor risks being eliminated from the class.
  23. First and second prize winners from classes, except the group of four and the Novice classes, will be eligible to compete in the Section Championships.
  24. Parking/Arrival at the Venue : Sheep must arrive on the Showground between 7.30 am and 9.30 am on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> August. All livestock vehicles must be parked as directed.
  25. Departure not before 4pm or the Championship Judging (whichever is latest) on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> August.
  26. All sheep must be removed from the showground by 11am on the day following the show. Sheep can arrive on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> August and leave on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> August by prior agreement only.
  27. All exhibitors must have their own third party public liability insurance.
  28. All animal fodder and bedding for an overnight stay must be provided by the exhibitor. No straw is allowed in the show pens.
  29. Every exhibit must, at the closing date of entries, be the bona fide property of the person / persons in whose name the entry is made.
  30. Any further rules the Badger Face Welsh Mountain Sheep Society deems it necessary to introduce after the production of this schedule will be binding on exhibitors.
  31. Rosettes to sixth place in all classes. NO PRIZE MONEY.
  32. Exhibitors are advised that it is not permissible to exhibit an animal under a judge that has bred, owned or been in any way economically involved in that animal. The onus to observe this rule lies with the exhibitor and not with the judge.
  33. No dogs are allowed on site.
  34. Please note the judge may request that the sheep be walked by hand in the show ring.
  35. Any complaint and/or objection, along with a £20 deposit should be submitted to the Chairman, in writing within 2 hrs of the incident. The deposit of £20 shall be refunded if the complaint and/or objection is upheld.

### **Bluetongue BTV-3**

It is recommended that all exhibitors vaccinate their animals against Bluetongue. All exhibitors must follow the regulations set by their own authorities or countries. We will continue to monitor the situation closely and issue further updates if needed. The BFWMSS reserves the right to update our guidance as the situation develops over the coming weeks and months.

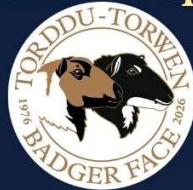
